If you could have dinner with any historical woman, who would it be and what would you ask her? Grace Kelly.. It's obvious!


One adjective to describe you the best Aqua woman

What & who inspired you to enter your profession?

I am a corporate techie who after 15 years in the industry, quit to enter into the social sector. In 2010, I went for a solo trek into high altitude Ladakh which changed my life. Faced with the extreme challenges of high altitude, poor acclimatization, rough terrain, and lack of basic infrastructure or support, I suffered from pulmonary oedema and found myself in a remote village, desperately trying to find my way back to medical care. I stayed the night at the only home in the village, cared for by the kindness of the local people and got my first taste of what life in Ladakh was really like.



I made a promise to make a difference to the lives of children living in these remote mountain villages, villages that I never knew existed till then. I started 17000 ft Foundation to ensure that even little children living in the remotest of mountain villages have access to the same high quality education as their more privileged counterparts.

If you could have a superpower for Women's Day, what would it be and why?

The power to enable all women to believe in themselves, to give as much to themselves as they give to others.

Can you share a career highlight that you're proud of?

My career highlight would be when I took the plunge to give up corporate life and step into the social sector.

If your life was a movie, who would play the lead role, and what would the title be?

I would love for Meryl Streep to play the lead role in a movie for which the title would be "Unstoppable Woman".

Two key challenges have you faced as a woman & share your solutions?

I have endured and survived domestic violence, and have walked out of my marriage with my three children who also bore the brunt of it. The separation was difficult and traumatic, but I rebuilt my life and that of my children and am happier for it. As a woman I also faced harassment, aggression and toxicity at work from a male colleague, which was ignored and disregarded, despite my complaints. I was asked to turn a blind eye and forced to continue to work with him. I fought the aggression and the system, but the system won. There still is such limited acknowledgement or understanding of the issues faced by women at the workplace and the resultant sheer neglect faced by them at home and the workplace is one that is being ignored.

If you could trade places with any fictional character for a day, who would it be and why?

Goddess Kali/Durga - she expresses the dual nature of the destruction that must come before new beginnings, and of the strength of the female power.

One advice you have for women entering your industry?

Your empáthy is your strength - Don't shy away from it or be apologetic about it. Wear it like your skin. Women make the best change makers.
